STRUCTURE: Abstract title in capitals. - Abstract text 1)

background/aims, 2) methods, 3) results and 4) conclusions. For case report, it should include introduction and case description. - Figure/table/graph to be included in the abstract should be submitted in IPG/BMP/GIF format,

maximum width 9cm, and resolution up to 150dpi. Please note that these may be resized to fit in the final printed materials. A maximum of 4 references can be included in the abstract. Do not include key words in the abstract. Abbreviation should be spelled out, in parenthesis, in the first use in the text.

Language: All abstracts should be submitted in English (including the title, abstract text, authors' names, affiliations, figures and graphs).
